- enrolment at 160!
- Hot Lunch Program off and running!
  - 140 + confirmed again for the year after a price increase (nearly 90% of students enrolled)
- Take Home supper program continues for families of the school community to remain in compliance with the CISKD Board's directive of last year
  - JP is expanding the program to include frozen dinners and goodies that will be available on an ongoing basis
  - Apple Pie Fundraiser is back. We sold nearly 250 pies!
