## Reading and Studying the Bible

*continue from last week...*

### Core Catholic Teachings on the Scriptures and Tradition

#### The Catholic Church teaches:

- Christ promised to send the Holy Spirit to his closest; followers, the Apostles, after he physically left them to ascend into heaven: “When he comes, the Spirit of truth, he will guide you to all truth” (Jn 16:13). The Holy Spirit helped the Apostles to remember and understand all that Jesus did and taught. These truths about Jesus and his teachings are therefore called the Apostolic Tradition, or sometime just the Tradition.
- Under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, the Apostles handed on everything they knew about Jesus to the first Christians and to the generation of leaders that followed them.
- The Holy Spirit inspired people in the early Church to create written documents explaining what the Apostles had handed down about Jesus.
- The Scriptures and Tradition are two sources of Revelation. They are closely connected and together form a single sacred deposit of truth under the guidance of the Holy Spirit. They can never be in conflict, and each one helps us to understand the other.
- The Church looks to God’s Revelation in the Scriptures and Tradition as the only authentic and complete source for knowledge about God and God’s will for the whole human race. It is the responsibility of the Church, through her teaching, her worship, and her ministries, to transmit to every new generation all that God has revealed.
- As the successors of the Apostles, it is the particular and exclusive responsibility of the bishops in union with the Pope—the Magisterium—to faithfully teach, interpret, and preserve the Scriptures and Tradition for all believers until Christ returns in glory.

## Prayer for Christian Unity January 18-25

The Week of Prayer for Christian Unity is celebrated around the world on January 18-25, which are also the dates recommended by the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops. However, there has also been a long-standing practice by a number of communities to celebrate the Week of Prayer on optional dates, in order to include two Sundays.

This universal week of prayer encourages Christians of all denominations to meet, to participate in various liturgical and other community activities, and to pray together that all may be one, as Christ desires.

The importance of unity among Christians and the responsibility of the people of each parish to work for this unity should be emphasized throughout the week. All members of the parish should seek to have a deeper understanding of ecumenism.

A resource kit containing program materials for the Week of Prayer, adapted for the Canadian context, may be purchased from the Canadian Council of Churches’ website, [www.councilofchurches.ca](http://www.councilofchurches.ca)

The texts of the Masses “For the Unity of Christians” in *The Roman Missal*, pp. 1261-1267 may be adapted for use during this week and celebrated on ferial days as a votive Mass.

Appropriate readings from Sacred Scripture are available in *Lectionary: Ritual Masses, Masses for Various Needs and Occasions, Masses for the Dead* in the section “For the Holy Church: For the Unity of Christians” nos. 867-871, pp. 461-479. In addition, the Gospel passages are found in the Book of Gospels pp. 653-660.

## Pope Leo XIV proclaims Franciscan Jubilee Year

Pope Leo XIV has proclaimed a “Special Year of St. Francis” to commemorate the 800th anniversary of the saint’s death. During this time of grace, which will extend until January 2027, the faithful are granted the opportunity to obtain a **plenary indulgence**.

This Franciscan Jubilee Year, considered a gift for the entire Church and an occasion for authentic spiritual renewal, was inaugurated on Jan. 10 with a **decree** issued by the Apostolic Penitentiary of the Holy See.

Until Jan. 10 of next year, the faithful can obtain this grace under the usual conditions—sacramental confession, Communion, and prayer for the intentions of the pope—by making a pilgrimage to any Franciscan conventual church or place of worship dedicated to St. Francis anywhere in the world.

Furthermore, the elderly, the sick, and those who, for serious reasons, cannot leave their homes can obtain the plenary indulgence by spiritually joining in the jubilee celebrations and offering their prayers, pains, or sufferings to God.

In a world where “the virtual takes over the real, disagreements and social violence are part of everyday life, and peace becomes more insecure and distant everyday, this Year of St. Francis spurs all of us, each according to our possibilities, to imitate the poor man of Assisi, to form ourselves as far as possible on the model of Christ,” the decree states.

For **the Order of Friars Minor**, this time is also an opportunity for the faithful to become “models of holiness of life and constant witnesses of peace.”

On the occasion of this anniversary, Pope Leo XIV addressed a **letter** to the ministries general of the Franciscan Family Conference in which he emphasized that “in this era, marked by so many seemingly endless wars, by internal and social divisions that create distrust and fear, he continues to speak. Not because he offers technical solutions, but because his life points to the authentic source of peace.”

In this regard, he highlighted that St. Francis reminds us that “peace with God, peace among people, and peace with creation are inseparable dimensions of a single call to universal reconciliation.”


