Our Lady of the Mountains

Holy Family Caminos, Summer 2026

Once again, Our Lady of the Mountains Parish in Whistler is offering Pilgrimage options this summer called the Holy Family Caminos.

What is a pilgrimage? It is a journey to a destination to remind us of our ultimate Journey in life. It is basically a walking retreat where we give God the opportunity of speaking to our lives and to do some of the necessary repairs.

Our first Camino of the Holy Family is 26th – 27th June:

Brandywine Falls to Our Lady of the Mountains Church (OLOM), total distance 25km.



Accommodation: Camping Friday night

Cost: Admin fee \$25, plus \$15 for campsite fee.

You are required to have your own food and gear.

Friday: Brandywine Falls to Cal-Cheak Crossing 5km

Saturday: Cal-Cheak Crossing to Our Lady of the Mountains 20km

There will be daily Mass and a retreat format to help you get the most out of the pilgrimage.

Second Camino of the Holy Family 26th – 30th July

St Joseph's, Squamish to Our Lady of the Mountains, total distance 96km. You will want to be in good shape for this one as you have to pack your gear and supplies for the whole time. A well packed person could get away with a 15-kilo pack including water.

Accommodation: Wilderness camping five nights.

Cost: Admin fee \$25, plus Levette Lake \$18 per campsite up to six

Sunday: St Joseph's to Levette Lake 18km, elevation gain 800m

Monday: Levette Lake to Queen of Peace Monastery 10km (rough terrain day) gain 300m, loss 600m

Tuesday: Queen of Peace Monastery to Starvation Lake 15km, elevation gain 650m, loss 470m

Wednesday: Starvation Lake to Cal-Cheak Crossing 24kms, elevation gain 1200m

Thursday: Cal-Cheak Crossing to Hanging Lake 17km

Friday: Hanging Lake to Our Lady of the Mountains 12km

There will be daily Mass and a retreat format to help you get the most out of the pilgrimage.



Third Camino of the Holy Family 4th – 7th September:

Mount Currie to OLOM, total distance 50km

Accommodation: Camping two nights. You are required to have your own food and gear.

Cost: Admin fee \$25

Friday: St Christopher's Church to St Francis of Assisi Church 10km

Saturday: St Francis of Assisi to Rock Garden 20km

Sunday: Rock Garden to OLOM 20km

There will be daily Mass and a retreat format to help you get the most out of the pilgrimage.

Pro-Life Help Not Harm Campaign – Bill C218 You are invited to visit HelpNotHarmCanada.ca to quickly and respectfully contact your Member of Parliament and ask for their support of **Bill C-218 (The Right to Recover Act)**. This proposed legislation would amend the Criminal Code to ensure that Medical Assistance in Dying (MAiD) is not extended to individuals whose sole underlying condition is mental illness. If the law is not amended, MAiD will become

available for those suffering from mental illness alone beginning in March 2027. Many of us know someone living with mental illness — a loved one, friend, neighbour, or colleague. As Catholics and Canadians, we are called to respond with compassion, accompaniment, and genuine care, safeguarding the dignity and lives of those who are vulnerable.
