Summary:

- St. James recorded a net income of over \$164K.
- Total revenues of \$466K are in the same range of revenues pre covid. Parishioners were
 especially generous with Faith in Action donations this year as represented by the \$84K
 rebate. The actual interest paid on account was over budget as a result of increased
 interest rates on the funds held in the DCB and an adjustment of interest paid for 2022.
- Total expenses were reasonably within budget. Church and Rectory maintenance is one of the biggest variance in this year's budget and the hardest to predict due to the age of the buildings. During the year the parking lot and back entrance were repaired and upgraded, the rectory roof was repaired, and a deposit was put on the carpet replacement in the church which was completed in January of this year. St James school also required additional repairs and maintenance with upgrades on the outside staircase as well as a new floor polisher. The Diocesan Assessment is based on donations and so higher donations will result in higher assessments. There was a significant decrease in insurance expense as a result of a diocese consolidation and review.
- Each year we set out to prepare a conservative budget. We started 2024 with upgrades
 to the carpet and the kneelers. Also planned for this year are repairs to the church front
 stairs, windows and casings, and possibly repainting. We continue our ongoing support
 for St. James School with tuition assistance and assisting with capital costs as the need
 arises. There is the possibility that a new commercial dishwasher for the St. James
 Hall/School kitchen will be needed in 2024.
- Last year our parish community in Vernon was active with a new youth program, a music
 program and ongoing adult education opportunities to enhance our faith journey.
 Please continue to bless this parish with your prayers, works, attendance, and financial
 support.
