I am Rev. Fr. Ignatius Obioma Opara, MSSCC, a Missionary of the Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary, hailing from the eastern part of Nigeria. Born on February 2, to Mr. and Mrs. Peter Opara, natives of Abazu Akabo in Ikeduru Local

Government Area, Imo State, Nigeria, I am proud to be the eldest of seven siblings - two girls and five boys - with both parents still blessed to be alive.

Growing up in a vibrant community in eastern Nigeria, I cultivated passions that complement my spiritual vocation. I love soccer, finding joy in the game's dynamism and teamwork, and in my spare moments, I delight in learning guitar, appreciating the harmony and expression music brings.

Academically, I pursued studies in Philosophy and Theology at Seat of Wisdom Seminary, an affiliate of the Pontifical Urban. University, Rome. This formation enriched my understanding of sacred sciences and deepened my commitment to ministerial service.

My journey in sacred ministry led to my ordination as a deacon in December 2019, culminating in my priestly ordination on July 8, 2021. Before embracing my mission here in Canada, I faithfully served for four years as the Pastor of Holy Cross Catholic Parish, Ndegwu, Owerri West Local Government Area, Imo State, Nigeria - a period marked by dedication to pastoral care and community engagement.

As a Missionary of the Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary, I strive to embody the charism of compassion and love central to my congregation, serving with humility and devotion wherever God's providence leads.


