

National Day for Truth and Reconciliation September 30, 2025

This year marks the 5th annual National Day for Truth and Reconciliation, and we do well on this occasion to recall Pope Francis' "penitential pilgrim—age" to Canada—a moment of grace in which the Holy Father reminded the Church about the former Indian Residential Schools and led the Church in seeking forgiveness from God and Indigenous Peoples for pas harms and their ongoing legacy.

The Bishops of Canada, individually and collectively, continue to invite us to journey with Indigenous Peoples on the path that leads to truth, healing, justice, reconciliation and hope, Today, let us each accept this invitation by praying for reconciliation so that our relationships with Indigenous Peoples may continue to grow in trust and mutual respect for a brighter future for all.


